DETAILS	Saturday's skirmish will be the assault by the 118 th Pennsylvania Regiment at Marye's Heights, Fredericksburg, December 1862. Union - please bring a greatcoat if you have one. This is part of the Marbury Merry Days Event in the Village. Please see attached flyer for other attractions.
NOTICES	Authentic camping is on the main field. The map on the flyer shows the position of the Confederate Camp. Union will be in the same place as in previous years. Please do not erect your tent before speaking to camp coordinators. Raised fires only please. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a leash. There will be some catering marquees as part of the event in the main field on both Saturday and Sunday. Sunday Church Service at 9.30 am, at St. Michael and All Angels Church, led by Rev. Veronica and all are warmly welcome to attend. Please make sure our display area is clear of litter before we leave the site. There will be a skip near the event marquees for rubbish. Water point is behind the marquees along the fence.
