Please make sure you have your membership card with you to gain access to the show site. After you have set up you must go to the admin tent next to the main arena and collect a wrist band this will allow you to leave and return to the show site, if you have children they must have a childs wrist band and please write your contact phone number on it just in case they get lost. As you enter the main site our camps will be to the left hand side of the field and the family camp/parking for us is in the same field.

Each day we are doing a drill/firing display in the morning and a skirmish with infantry, artillery and pyros in the afternoon.

Please can you also remember to bring your licenses with you so ACWS records can be updated.

Camping from Thursday till Monday morning

Public on site 10am Saturday and Sunday

Raised fires only. Please remove turfs and replace at the end of the event.

All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

Rubbish is to be placed in the skips provided.

There is a speed limit of 5mph on the whole of the festival site.

Family camp users please note no camp fires or BBQs at ground level.

WELCOME to SHACKERSTONE FAMILY FESTIVAL 2019

Please find your individual Weekend Wristbands which are **to be WORN at all times.** These will allow easy access in and around the
Festival site or when returning to the site from along the canal and
village and access for Friday & Saturday evening's entertainment. **WRISTBANDS** for **Adults** are **SKY BLUE** (for Children please see
reference below). If you have been sent an admittance receipt this will
be exchanged when presented on arrival for your wristbands. If you
damage or misplace your wristbands at the Festival please call at
admin with proof of identification for a replacement wristband.

IF YOU HAVE A CHILD WITH YOU REQUIRING A WRISTBAND — CHILDREN HAVE FREE ENTRY TO THE 2019 FESTIVAL WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT –If you wish to have a wristband for your CHILD please collect their wristband when booking in at the Administration Marquee. We ask that you write your mobile telephone number on your child's wristband. Our experience has found that most 'lost children' at the Festival are either staying on the

site or with someone who is participating in the Festival - Your help will save a lot of time & distress.

VEHICLE PASSES – These MUST BE DISPLAYED on the right hand side of your windscreen and please put your mobile telephone number in the space provided. Regretfully those not displaying their passes will sadly be refused entry. PLEASE BE ATTENTIVE OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT CHECKPOINTS & LANES. Only park in the space you are provided & please do not park on, or obstruct, public highways or gateways.

DIRECTIONS – (The Festival Site sat nav. is **CV13 6NH**) From the M42 & A5 use the A444 towards Twycross. In Twycross travel to Congerstone and follow the festival signs near the telephone box in the village centre, whilst those who find themselves in Shackerstone travel southwards to Congerstone. At the junction with the phone box please then follow the relevant festival signs to the required location.

UPON ARRIVAL – Access to the EXHIBITOR display location on Saturday & Sunday is from 8am until 9.45am. Unless by prior arrangement those arriving after this time will likely be asked to park in the Main Car Park. Festival stewards will direct you on arrival to the appropriate designated location for your exhibit. BOOKING IN & FESTIVAL PLAQUES – Once sited please book in at the Admin between 9am & 12noon. At Admin you will be able to purchase a Festival Programme and/or Festival Plaque whilst stocks last.

NO VEHICULAR MOVEMENTS (or non exhibit parking) on the two main Festival Fields on Saturday & Sunday from 9.45am to 5.15pm unless authorised by David Lock or Chris Simmons (Joint Site Managers), Neil Bonser (Exhibitor Coordinator) or Wayne O'Shea (Health & Safety Officer). Your attention is drawn to the Motor Vehicles (off road events) Regulations 1992 where the Road Traffic Act can apply at the Festival. Subject to no site safety problems at 4pm each day exhibitors may start to leave using the designated trackway however the Festival and the Public would prefer to see exhibits stay until the close at 5pm.

AMENITIES - Water is available from a number of tap sources. On ALL Festival fields the use of vehicles for water collection is only permitted on Saturday & Sunday before 9.45am and after 5.45pm (site limit 5 mph). At other times by foot access only - Your cooperation is appreciated. Toilets, Elson tanks and Waste Rubbish Skips are at various locations.

THE BEER FESTIVAL MARQUEE & REFRESHMENTS AREA are both available from Friday lunchtime. They are both open on Friday and Saturday evenings when the ENTERTAINMENT in the Beer Festival Marquee on Friday evening is the Pop & Rock Band LOUNGE VIPERS whilst on Saturday evening the talented female vocal cords of BLUE SAVANNAH. Please bring a torch; it's a dark walk back to your bed. Please note the evenings are not open to the general public so you will need to be wearing your wristband at all times.

ADDITIONAL REQUESTS Please keep all children and pets behind the fencing segregating the river from the public area. Dogs MUST be on leads at all times and litter is to be placed in the bins or skips provided. The Festival takes place on farmland and we would like to be invited to use the site again. Your co-operation is appreciated. Should you have any problems or need any assistance over the weekend, please contact Administration immediately.
